As the City plans for the future, we want to respect our past and address the needs and opinions of our community's seniors.

The City is in the process of updating its General Plan, the policy document that will serve as a "blueprint" for the future of the community. The General Plan identifies a Community Vision that the City will strive to achieve over the next 20 years, and contains goals, policies, and implementation measures that will guide growth and change. The General Plan will contain chapters or "elements" that address the following:

- Land Use
- Transportation
- Economic Development
- Historic Preservation
- Noise
- Parks and Open Space
- Infrastructure
- Urban Design (how our streets look)
- Safety

As long-time citizens of Orange, we know that you have a great deal of insight into the community's evolution and we'd like to hear what you have to say about it. We would also like your input about how the City could better serve its seniors, and what issues face our aging population. For instance,

- Do you plan to remain in Orange in the years ahead?
- Are the goods and services needed by seniors easily accessible in Orange?
- How easy is it to get around town for those who no longer drive?
- Are members of your extended family able live nearby to provide you with assistance in your Golden Years?
- Do you feel safe in the community?
